

Dinosaur Bones Support Biblical Account

I rarely watch 60 Minutes, but the subject of dinosaurs caught my attention last night. If you didn't see the segment, I'll give the short of it. A scientist and a paleontologist have discovered that dinosaur bones contain soft tissues. This is impossible according to all scientific theory. The things Schweitzer was finding inside dinosaur bones - blood vessels, and even what seemed to be intact cells - pose a radical challenge to the existing rules of science: that organic material can't possibly survive even one million years, let alone 68 million.

(CBS) Schweitzer, Horner and their team published their B. Rex findings in a series of papers in the journal "Science" and were promptly attacked.

Critics said their samples might have been contaminated, or that the supposed blood vessels were actually something called "biofilm," a type of slime.

But as Schweitzer showed Stahl, she has been able to replicate her findings.

She dissolved away pieces of an even older dinosaur - a well-preserved 80-million-year-old duckbill - in acid, and again, as she showed Stahl, found what appear to be blood vessels.

"It's so consistent, over and over and over again. We do this bone and it comes out and I get excited every time. I can't help it. I mean, 80 million years old," Schweitzer told Stahl.

Of course the evolutionist will come up with some explanation to dismiss the obvious; that the bone is not 80 million years old. Again the only evolution we see is in the theory of evolution. I wonder how they will deal with this one.
